<u>The Turbotville Community Hall 100 Years</u> <u>By Leon Hagenbuch</u>

The Turbotville Community Hall will be 100 years old this year, 2022. This report was in the Turbotville Times Newspaper on September 29, 1922. Financial Report of Community Hall to the taxpayers of Turbotville Borough: The following is a Financial Report of the Community Hall to the date of September 19, 1922, given by the Borough Council. Resources May, 3 - deposited at bank \$2,649.43, June, 20 - deposited at bank \$2,500.00, September, 11 received from club \$1,300.00. Total of \$6,449.43. September, 19, received from club for roof \$4,000.00. Liabilities: W.D. Schuyler - for labor \$1,408.61, Luther Martin - for Architectural Work \$190.00, Hartly & Blaine - for cement & hardware \$657.68, B. Savidge - for hardware \$13.50, George C. Wertman - for lumber \$534.50, J.W. Wertman - for labor \$28.00, Wm. Yerg for labor \$28.00, Johm Y. Buoy - for dynamite \$14.75, Doebler Concrete Pipe Co. - for blocks & Work \$1,177.47, Wm. Grittner - for lumber \$655.00, Shippers Car Line - for steel \$418.46, Watsontown Door and Sash - for lumber \$865.11, Harris Hester - for sand \$14.00, Isaac Shaffer - for lumber \$500.00. Total \$6,490.40. Bills unpaid to date: Elmer Winters - for Mason Work \$421.20, Chas Patterson - for Mason Work \$68.40, Isaac Shaffer - for lumber \$365.53, Watsontown Brick Co. - for bricks \$22.20, Wm. Grittner – for Lumber \$1,000.29, Doebler Concrete Pipe Co. - for blocks \$578.52. Totals \$2,456.14. This report shows a deficit at present date of \$2,497.00, not calculating the \$400.00 donated for the roof. The larger materials are purchased with the exceptions of doors and inside trim. Hoping this report will meet the favor of the public. We are respectfully The Borough Council
